	(i) details of the proposals for a neighbourhood development plan;
	(ii) details of where and when the proposals for a neighbourhood development plan may be inspected;
	(iii) details of how to make representations; and
	(iv) the date by which those representations must be received, being not less than 6 weeks from the date on which the draft proposal is first publicised;
	As we have demonstrated in the Consultation Statement, the Parish Council is satisfied that the regulations concerning consultation have been met and have resulted in Mr Mutimer being able to submit comments for consideration.
