Children are welcome at these premises but to make sure they remain safe please observe the following:-

- STAFF do not have responsibility for keeping YOUR CHILDREN under control
- ADULTS must remain with their children and SUPERVISE THEM AT ALL TIMES
- PLEASE DRINK RESPONSIBLY – Children are vulnerable if adults are intoxicated
- IT IS AN OFFENCE to buy alcohol for children
- WATCH YOUR DRINKS! – Even a small amount of alcohol can be dangerous for a child
- CHILDREN MUST BE OFF THE PREMISES BY:
