Notice is hereby given that Babergh and Mid Suffolk District Councils are carrying out a consultation in relation to the Babergh and Mid Suffolk Joint Local Plan. The consultation is being carried out under Regulation 18 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012. The consultation period is ten weeks commencing on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2019 and concluding at **4pm on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> September 2019**.

**WHAT IS THE JOINT LOCAL PLAN?**

The Joint Local Plan will relate to the area covered by Babergh District Council and Mid Suffolk District Council and will set out planning policies for the two Districts up to 2036. It will identify the amount of development required and allocate sites for development.
