



**NOTICE OF THE PUBLICATION OF THE BABERGH AND MID SUFFOLK JOINT
LOCAL PLAN
Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004
Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as
amended) (Regulation 19)**

Notice is hereby given that Babergh and Mid Suffolk District Councils are publishing their Pre-Submission Joint Local Plan and its accompanying Sustainability Appraisal and Habitats Regulations Assessment. This is known as Regulation 19 and is the final opportunity to make representations on the draft plan before it is submitted to a Planning Inspector for consideration through an Examination in Public.

The Joint Local Plan relates to the area covered by Babergh District Council and Mid Suffolk District Council and sets out planning policies to manage development in the two Districts up to 2037. It identifies the amount of development required and allocates sites for development.

The Babergh and Mid Suffolk Joint Local Plan Pre-Submission (Regulation 19) Document (November 2020) and accompanying documents are available to view on the Councils' websites at: www.babergh.gov.uk/jointlocalplan or www.midsuffolk.gov.uk/jointlocalplan

In response to the Covid-19 pandemic, all documentation will only be published online in accordance with the latest Government guidance. Hard copies of the Joint Local Plan will be available on request at the cost of printing plus postage and packing.

Representations are invited on the legal compliance and soundness of the Joint Local Plan Pre-Submission (Regulation 19) Document. The period for submission of representations will run for six weeks between **Thursday 12th November and 12 noon on Thursday 24th December 2020**. Representations must be received by the Councils within this period.

Digital copies of the representation form can also be downloaded from the Councils' websites, where further information on making representations can be read.
