Notice is given that Mid Suffolk District Council proposes to make a local listed building consent order to allow certain 'specified works' to windows and glazed or part-glazed doors in 'defined circumstances' in Grade II Listed Buildings to proceed without the need to apply to the Council for Listed Building Consent
