The Club is well known within the Suffolk bowls community for its exceptional green, accessible car park, and inclusive facilities. We actively encourage participation from young people and their families, and we have a designated safeguarding officer to ensure a safe and supportive environment for all.

- 1. There will be no licensable entertainment taking place either inside or outside the building which would involve amplified music or speech.
- 2. There will be no activities within the building that may give rise to concern in respect of children.
- 3. Any person attempting to purchase or consume alcohol on the licensed premises and appearing to be under the age of 21 shall be challenged and required to produce a valid photographic identity document as proof of age.
- 4. The capacity of persons on the premises shall be monitored and controlled to ensure there is safe occupancy.
- 5. For events involving licensable activities, the premises holder shall ensure adequate provision of first aid personnel and equipment are made available.
- 6. Lighting and emergency lighting shall be installed and maintained to ensure good levels of visibility at all times.
- 7. The premises licence holder shall take all steps to minimise the risk of disturbance to local residents at all times.
- 8. The premises licence holder shall ensure that notices detailing emergency evacuation shall be displayed prominently and adequate arrangements to ensure the safe evacuation of any disabled persons on the premises.
- 9. An adequate supply of first aid materials shall be kept on the licensed premises.
- 10. There will be two competent members of the Club present at all events on the licensed premises, who will be responsible in the event of any emergency occurrence.
- 11. All members will be told they must leave the premises quietly and with respect to the needs of neighbouring properties and a programme of events will be available to all close residents to the licensed premises.
- 12. The premises licence holder shall have in place a Child and Vulnerable Adult Policy which will require a designated safeguarding officer.
- 13. No illegal drugs shall be permitted on the premises.
- 14. Internal and external lighting provided for the purpose of customer and staff safety, and for the security of the premises, shall be positioned so as to not cause nuisance to neighbouring or adjoining properties.
- 15. Waste from the licensed premises shall be removed in a timely manner to minimise the risk to public nuisance.
- 16. Activities involving young people will be supervised and held in safe inclusive environments.
- 17. Violent or bad behaviour will not be tolerated, neither will bad language. The offending person(s) will be referred to the Management Committee for consideration.
